Petitioner is husband and he has already remained in jail custody for more than three months in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498 A, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act and it appears from the impugned order that there is no possibility of reconciliation between petitioner and informant.
