Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

Informant along with his wife while was in a way to
their house on a motorcycle, were intercepted by unknown
criminals, who on the pretext of firearm snatched away
motorcycle.

From perusal of the case diary, it is apparent that
petitioner along with others were apprehended in connection with
Motipur P. S. Case no.07 of 2013, during course of which, they
made inculpatory extra-judicial confessional statement and on the
basis thereof, petitioner along with others have been remanded in
this case. Neither, they have been put on T. I. Parade nor
motorcycle has been recovered as yet. Chargesheet had already
been submitted.

Accordingly, petitioner, **Randhir Bhagat** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Mr. Rajiv Kumar-IV, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Sadar, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Mehsi P. S. Case no.298 of 2012.
