The petitioners seek bail in case registered for the offence under Sections 304(B), 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law of the deceased.

Informant, Bhola Das, made allegation that his daughter was married to Dilchand Das, the son of the petitioners. He made allegation that the accused persons killed his daughter on account of non-fulfillment of dowry. It appears that informant has not

made any specific allegation of assault and demand of dowry against the petitioners. The petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law.

Considering the facts and the nature of allegations made against the petitioners, who happens to be the father-in-law and mother-in-law of the deceased, the petitioners named above is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Gurua P.S. Case No. 40 of 2014.
