ORAL ORDER

2 29-01-2015 Heard both sides.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in Durgawati P.S.
Case No. 114/2010 registered under Section 396 of the Indian
Penal Code.

The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
name of the petitioner figured in the case in the confessional
statement of co-accused Rambali Mushar, but nothing has been
recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The looted mobile
is said to have been recovered from the possession of Ramesh
Kumar Yadav and Vikash Kumar Yadav and Vikash Kumar
Yadav is said to have disclosed that he had purchased the mobile
from the petitioner.

Considering the facts that although the petitioner was arrested on 02.04.2014 on the basis of the confessional statement of Ram Bali Mushar but nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and the petitioner was not put on T.I.P., the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Ad hoc Addl. Sessions Judge III, Kaimur in S. T. No. 301/236 of 2014, arising out of Durgawati P.S. No. 114/2010.
