petition so that the petitioner may avail statutory remedy.

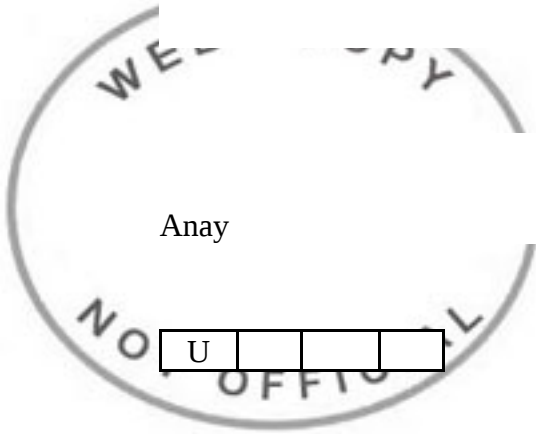
The prayer is allowed.
