Petitioner is not named in the First Information Report but
in course of investigation his name surfaced in confessional
statement of co-accused and it came to light that one looted
motorcycle had been kept in the house of the petitioner. Moreover,
one looted motorcycle of another case was recovered from the
house of the petitioner.
