P.C. was recorded in which, the victim supported the story of kidnapping and rape but submission on behalf of the petitioner is that the petitioner was well-known to the victim, prior to the alleged occurrence and as a matter of fact, they were in sweet relation and the victim being major, left home by her own sweet will but after institution of this case, she returned to her home and she came under the influence of her parents and that is the reason, she took “U” turn.

Considering the above-said submission as well as facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above, be

released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Laheriasarai P.S. Case No. 424 of 2014 to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga.
