The terms of compromise are as follows:

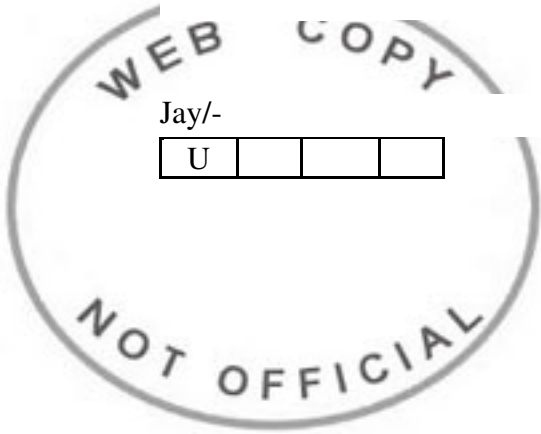
“Keeping in view that the dispute between the workman

the court, the parties to this compromise have decided to
withdraw and not to pursue Complaint Case No.
3147(C)/2004 pending before the Judicial Magistrate Court,
Patna, CWJC No. 5746/2004 & Cr. Misc.No. 52605/2006
pending before Hon’ble Patna High Court.

This is full and final settlement and there is no further
claim from both the parties against each other”.

In this view of the matter, the Bank of Baroda does not want to

press this petition.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed as not pressed.
