ORAL ORDER

2 16-06-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been alleged that there is altercation between
informant and petitioner. Petitioner threatened her to kill her
husband and after some time the dead body of her husband
was recovered from canal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that except
this allegation there is no allegation against the petitioner and
merely on suspicion she has made them accused. One Ranjeet
Muni and Mantu Muni has been granted bail by this Court
vide Cr. Misc. No.2251 of 2015.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let petitioner, Champa Devi, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.D.J. 3rd, Katihar in S.T. No.87 of 2015 arising out of Korha P.S. Case No.137 of 2013, subject to the conditions that (i) That one of the bailors will be close relative of the petitioner who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioner. The bailor will also undertake to inform the Court if there is any change in the address of the petitioner (ii) That the affidavit shall clearly state that the petitioner is not an accused in any other case and if he is, he shall not be released on bail (iii) That the bailor shall also state on affidavit that he will inform the court concerned if the petitioner is implicated in any other case of similar nature after his release in the present case and thereafter the court below will be at liberty to initiate the proceeding for cancellation of bail on the ground of misuse (iv) That the petitioner will give an undertaking that he will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if he fails to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, his bail will be liable to be

cancelled for reasons of misuse (v) That the petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, her bail will be liable to be cancelled.
