5 01-09-2015 It is undisputed that without leading evidence, therefore, forthwith, the S.D.M., Samastipur in M.R. No.213 of 2010 declared the possession of the opposite parties in a proceeding under Section 145 Cr.PC. by order dated 03.10.2013 which is evidently contrary to the provisions of law.
