Heard the parties.

Although the petitioner complains of encroachment by the private respondent nos.4 to 14 but it is admitted that no formal application under the provisions of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') has been filed before the statutory authority.

In the circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to file a properly constituted

application in terms of 'the Act' before the statutory authority by impleading the alleged encroachers and demonstrating the extent of encroachment made by each of them and any application being filed would be considered and disposed of by the statutory authority in accordance with law and after giving an opportunity of hearing to the parties including the encroachers.
