learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State. Also heard

learned counsel for the B.S.FC.

Petitioner happens to be rice miller and he is
languishing in jail custody since 20.04.2015 in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that no case under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code
is made out and, at best, it is a case of breach of contract.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as

well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabua in connection with Durgawati P.S. Case No. 50 of 2015.
