and 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks quashing
of the F.I.R. of Madhuban P.S.Case No. 87 of 2005 dated 23rd
June, 2005 registered for the offences punishable under sections
396, 307, 436 and 353(A) of the Indian Penal Code, section 27 of
the Arms Act, section 3/4 of the Explosive Substances Act and
