03/ 30.10.2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned Addl.
Public Prosecutor for the State as well as learned counsel for the
informant.

The alleged occurrence took place on 19.10.2014 and it is
alleged that petitioner nos.2 and 3 assaulted the deceased by means of
lathi.

Fardbeyan of the deceased was recorded on the next date of
the occurrence and in course of treatment, he died on 4.11.2014. Post
mortem report of the deceased reveals that one injury was found on
the head of the deceased whereas another injury was found on his
right hand. The head injury of the deceased became fatal for deceased.

Petitioners are in jail custody since 9.2.2015 and the alleged

occurrence took place on the point of petty dispute. Petitioners do not have any criminal antecedent.

Accordingly, petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madhepura in Alamnagar P.S. Case no. 153/2014.
