Petitioner happens to be mother in law of the deceased. The impugned order of learned Additional Sessions Judge reveals that death of the deceased was unnatural but submission on behalf of the petitioner is that the husband of the deceased has already been sent to judicial custody and the younger brother in law of the deceased has been admitted to anticipatory bail by this Court.
