The petitioner seeks bail in a case under Section 302
and other sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleged that his daughter was married
to Anil Singh in the year 2006. On 06.11.2014, the informant got
information that his daughter was strangled to death and her
dead body was cremated. The petitioner is the father-in-law of the
deceased. No specific allegation of demand of dowry and torture is
made against the petitioner.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named
petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond
of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like

amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari in Ramgarhwa P.S. Case No. 181 of 2014.
