Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated
28.9.2012 by which the Additional Sessions Judge-3, Danapur, in
Sessions Trial No. 73 of 2011 refused an application under Sections
227/228 Cr. P.C.

Considering that even if charge under Section 307 is
framed, no prejudice would be caused to the Petitioner and charge can
be amended at any stage of trial, I am not inclined to interfere in the
matter.

The application stands dismissed.
