The Counsel for the Opposite Party No.2 submits that she has remarried and now she has no grievance with the Petitioner.

In the interest of parties, the judgment of conviction dated 16.01.2008 and order of sentence dated 17.01.2008 passed by the 1st Assistant Sessions Judge, Sitamarhi in Sessions Trial No.427 of 2004/08 of 2004 (arising out of Pupri P.S. Case No.105/2003), by which, the petitioner has been convicted under Sections 324, 307, 498A of the I.P.C. and Section 34 of Dowry Prohibition Act and sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for 2 years, 7 years, 2 years and simple imprisonment for six months respectively with fine, which was affirmed by judgment dated 4.07.2014 passed by 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Sitamarhi passed in Criminal Appeal No.06 of

2008/19 of 2013 are set aside.

The petitioner, who is in custody, be released forthwith,
if not wanted in any other case.
