3 05-10-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code
and Sections 27/25(I-b) of the Arms Act.

As per the prosecution story, it is alleged that the
petitioner with his single barrel gun fired shot which resulted into
the death of Lalita Singh Yadav. There was land dispute between
the parties.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner is in custody since 16.12.2014. Charge sheet has been
submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering with
the evidence.

As per the allegation petitioner is the assailant. It is case and counter case. Father of the petitioner has also died in course of the occurrence.

It has been submitted on behalf of the State that the petitioner is named in the First Information Report and there is direct allegation of firing against him.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to the grant bail to this petitioner and the same is rejected.

Anyhow, the Trial Court is directed to take all necessary steps to conclude the trial preferable within one year from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
