2. 10-11-2015 Heard Sri Dudh Nath Singh, learned counsel for the
petitioner and Smt. Nirmala Kumari, learned Addl. Public
Prosecutor.

This is the second attempt for grant of bail on behalf
of petitioner. Earlier, the prayer for bail of the petitioner was
rejected on 09-03-2015, vide Cr. Misc. No. 40930 of 2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is in custody since 24-05-2014. He submits that after
the commitment, charge has already been framed on 01-09-2015.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is the husband of
the deceased as well as earlier on merit the prayer for bail of the
petitioner was already rejected and now the trial has already
commenced, there is no reason to extend the privilege of bail.

The petition stands dismissed.

The learned trial court is required to proceed with the case so that trial may come to its logical end without unnecessary delay.
