The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order of
non-discharge dated 20.05.2015 passed by the Sub-
divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patna in Complaint Case
No. 1208(C) of 2009.

Considering that the Petitioner seeks quashing
on disputed questions of fact which can not be gone into
at this stage, I am not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The Application is dismissed.

The Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial
and conclude the same without granting unnecessary
adjournment to any party. For which reason, he is
