4 02-11-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner was arrested in connection with Dawath P.S. Case No. 110 of 2014 and some articles were recovered from his conscious possession but learned counsel, appearing for petitioner referring paragraph-31 of the case diary submits that the recovered articles are not looted property of the present case.It is further pointed out by him that having more or less similar allegation, co-accused Akhilesh Kumar has already been granted privilege of bail by a coordinate bench of this court.
