2 18-12-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.P.P.

for the State and also learned counsel for the informant.

Petitioner, namely, Manish Kumar Singh @ Manish Singh is in custody in Jamo Bazar P.S. Case No.87 of 2015 under Sections 341, 307, 506/34 and 302 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

From perusal of the F.I.R., it appears that the petitioner along with two co-accused persons named in the F.I.R. indiscriminately fired at the deceased husband of the informant who died during the treatment in the hospital after 1-2 days. Therefore, although in F.I.R. only section 307 I.P.C. was there subsequently section 302 I.P.C. was added.

In view of the allegation that there is indiscriminate

firing by three accused persons and that the deceased died during course of treatment and only on the ground that the deceased has received one fire injury, the petitioner does not deserve bail at this stage. Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.
