ORAL JUDGMENT

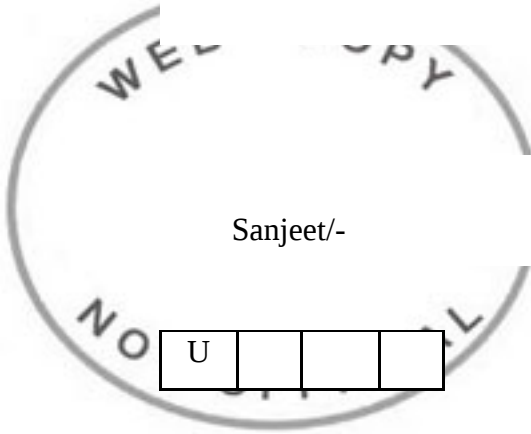
