2 04-02-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner prays for anticipatory bail in a police
case registered under Sections 498A and 307/34 of the Indian
Penal Code, in which the victim girl subsequently died.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner aged about 60 years is the mother-in-law of the victim
girl and for the said reason she ought to be granted anticipatory
bail.

From a perusal of the first information report, which
was given by the victim girl herself, it appears that the husband of

the victim girl poured K.Oil on her and by lighting of the match the petitioner, who is the mother-in-law of the victim girl, set her on fire.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is, accordingly, rejected.
