The petition seeks to question the election of the respondent No.6 to the post of Chairman, Chaiful Primary Agriculture Credit Cooperative Society, Block Manjhi in the district of Saran.

Section 14A(6) of the Bihar Cooperative Societies Act (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') read with Rule 21X and the provisions framed thereunder and the provisions of Bihar State Election Authority Act mandates that a challenge to the election of a returned candidate under the provisions of 'the Act' can only be made by way of an election petition. The writ petition does not disclose whether any such attempt was made by the petitioner to

question the election of the private respondent.

In the circumstances, the writ petition is held not maintainable and is disposed of accordingly.
