The hyper technicality and the plea, which has been taken on behalf of BISCOMAUN is not accepted position in law.

After perusing the materials on record, the Court gets a clear feeling that the authorities of BISCOMAUN wants to frustrate, delay and dilate the advantage earned by the petitioner by way of adjudication made on his appeal contained in Annexure- 18.

The respondents are directed to place the matter of the petitioner, if required, before the Board of Governors, who have a duty and obligation to decide the matter in accordance with law within four weeks from today or else all of them are going to be dealt

with under suitable provision of law of contempt as they are already in default with regard to previous direction.

Writ is disposed of in terms of above.
