ORAL ORDER

3 20-03-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 325, 307, 379, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that the accused persons including the petitioners assaulted the informant, informant's brother Ram Prasad and brother's wife Rekha Devi (Bhavo)

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the injuries of all three injured have been found to be superficial simple in nature and there is counter version of occurrence also. A statement has been made in paragraph no. 3 of the petition that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case No. 10 of 2014 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Gaya, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
