The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in

a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections

Accusation is causing injury with knife on
the head of the informant and snatching Rs. 800/-.

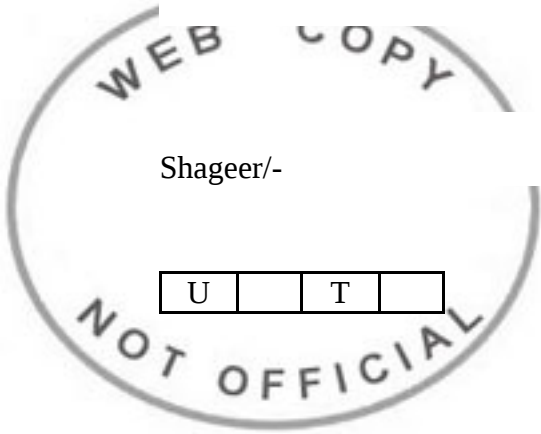
It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that injury has been found to be superficial, simple
in nature.

A statement has been made in para 3 of the
petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

The aforesaid facts constitute ground for
consideration of prayer for regular bail, if the petitioner
surrenders within a period of six weeks and pray for regular
bail in connection with Panapur P.S. Case No. 91 of 2014,
pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate,

Saran, Chapra.
