ORAL ORDER

2 04-03-2015 Petitioner being husband of the informant is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A, 504, 506/34 of the I.P.C.

The basic accusation is of torture for non-fulfilment of dowry demand.

On instructions, it is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is ready to keep the informant as wife with full dignity and honour. A statement to that effect has been made in para 15 of the petition which reads as follows:-

“That the petitioner is husband and is ready to keep his wife with full dignity and quite peaceful”

Considering the present stand of the

petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on provisional anticipatory bail for one year, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Industrial P.S. Case No. 103 of 2014.

Let learned Court below issue notice to the informant and fix a date for her appearance. On appearance, the petitioner will take the informant to her matrimonial house to keep her as wife with full dignity and honour.

The provisional anticipatory bail of the petitioner will be confirmed by the learned Court below in three eventualities (i) On substantial restoration of the matrimonial harmony within a period of one year (ii) If the informant fails to appear before learned Court below (iii) If the informant is reluctant to reconcile the issue.
