3 15-09-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with a
case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420 /
467/448 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 7 of the
Essential Commodities Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner
is a Public Distribution System dealer and has falsely been
implicated in this case and the allegations levelled against him is
mischievous as the food-grains which are said to be missing from
the godown of the petitioner, have in fact, been distributed
amongst the beneficiaries of the said food-grains. It is further
submitted that there was no complaint from any quarter in this
regard but a false and mischievous allegation has been made

against him as a result of which, he is facing prosecution.

Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioner and also the fact that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent of similar nature, let the petitioner Ramakant Mishra, in the event of his arrest / surrender within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the each amount to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sadar at Motihari, East Champaran, in connection with Kotwa P.S. Case No. 289 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
