and the State.

Petitioners are apprehending their arrest
in a case under Section 47A of the Excise Act. They are
the staff of India made foreign liquor shop, have been
found selling India made foreign liquor on a Dry Day. It
is submitted on their behalf that their antecedent is
absolutely clean, which fact be verified by the court

below and if true, petitioners, named above be admitted to the privilege of bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- (five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sasaram, Rohtas in connection with Nokha P.S. Case No. 168/13, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C., provided they surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order in the court below. Until such verification, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioners.
