ORAL ORDER

2 19-02-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioners being the parents of the husband of the victim are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304B and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing the daughter of the informant after five years of the marriage for non-fulfilment of the dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that as per the own admission of the informant, he was informed about the illness of the victim. The postmortem report does not reflect any external injury and the cause of death has not been ascertained, though, the viscera has been preserved. Moreover,

during investigation, witnesses have not supported the accusation of demand of dowry.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Nawada in connection with Warisaliganj P.S. Case No. 192 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
