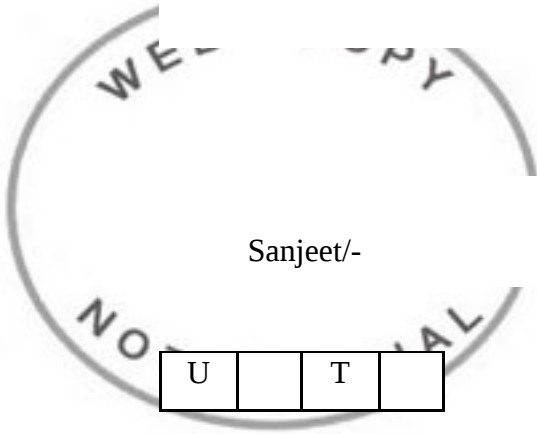
ORAL ORDER
