The petitioner who is father-in-law apprehends his arrest in a case instituted under Sections 384/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The complainant who is daughter-in-law submits that earlier she had filed a case under Section 498A in which some compromise was arrived at and some affidavits was filed.

In the instant case it is alleged that the accused persons were forcibly demanded the papers. The petitioner dense the same.

Considering the facts of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Court below within four weeks from today, let the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5000/-(five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial

Magistrate, 1st Class, Katihar in Complaint Case No. 2486 of 2013 subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and that the petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail will be liable to be cancelled.
