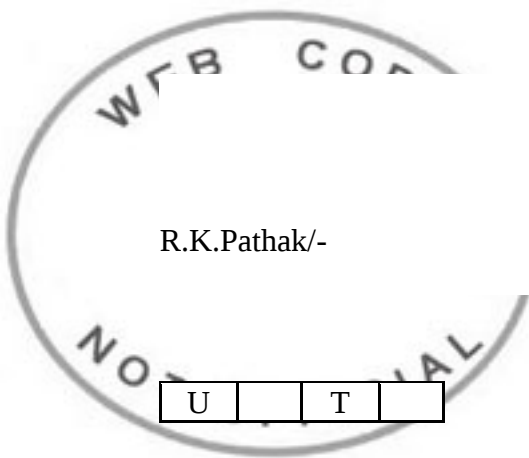

ORAL ORDER

2 04-03-2015 Petitioner No.4 Anju Devi is said to be dead. Therefore, prayer for anticipatory bail on her behalf has become infructuous.

So far as petitioners No.1, 2 and 3 are concerned, looking at the mob action which is alleged as well as taking into consideration that petitioners are also of the weaker section, let petitioners Rajmati Devi, Laxmiya Devi and Laksho Devi, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.15,000/- (fifteen thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad, in connection with Risiup P S Case No. 18/2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of

Criminal Procedure.
