ORAL ORDER

2 03-03-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners being the parents and brother of the husband of the victim are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304(B) and 328/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of causing death of the daughter of the informant after three years of marriage.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that post mortem reflects no external injury particularly resisting injury though specific accusation is that the accused persons administered poison to the victim. The doctor has also not ascertained actual cause of death and Viscera has been preserved.

Considering the thrust of accusation against the husband of the victim, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today in connection with Kurasakanta P.S. Case No. 121 of 2014 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Araria, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
