ORAL ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to the Opposite Parties No. 2 to 12 by the Sessions Judge, West Champaran Camp Court at Bagaha, vide A.B.P. No.300 (C)

of 2014 arising out of Bagaha Police Station Case No. 499 of 2014.

It has been submitted that on false grounds, the Opposite Parties have been granted anticipatory bail and, hence, it should be cancelled.

On going through the impugned order, I find that the Sessions Judge, West Champaran, Camp Court Bagaha, has considered the case on merits and found fit the Opposite Party to be released on bail and, hence, I see no reason for interference in the matter.

The application stands rejected.
