3 02-07-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in
connection with Dumra P.S. Case No.407 of 2014 for allegedly
having committed the offence under Sections 302, 341, 323,
307, 379 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there
is no specific allegation against the petitioner. The main role
has been assigned to one Ramesh Prasad Sah. It is further
submitted that the name of the petitioner has been falsely
included on account of the fact that he is son of Parvati Devi,
who has since been extended the privilege of anticipatory bail
vide Cr.Misc. No.10680 of 2015.

Considering the aforementioned submissions and the nature of allegations, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi, in connection with Dumra P.S. Case No.407 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
