4 02-07-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This is an application seeking anticipatory bail in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420 and 406
of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner, who was the Panchayat Secretary of
Panchayat Baruhi in the district of Buxar, allegedly, he in
collusion with the Mukhiya of the said Gram Panchayat diverted
the funds meant for Anganbari to purchase the solar light.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
has submitted that even on the basis of the First Information
Report, no case is made out that the petitioner misappropriated any
amount for his personal use.

In view of the submission as above, let the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur, Ara in connection with Sahar P.S. Case No. 111 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
