Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

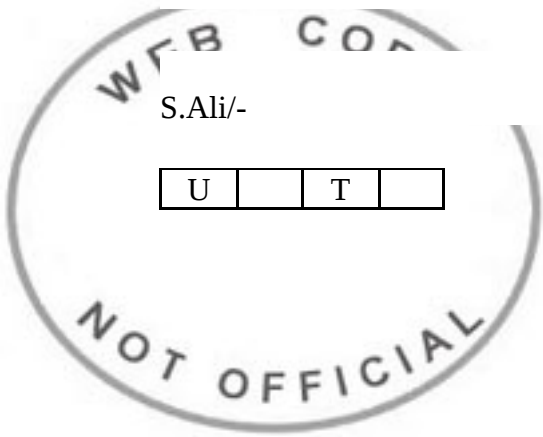
The Petitioner was allowed Provisional anticipatory bail by the order dated 16.1.2015.
