3 26-03-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned A.P.P. and learned counsel for the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that during the course of investigation, the police found the allegation to be false and accordingly submitted final form finding the case to be false. He may, therefore, be permitted to withdraw the anticipatory bail application with liberty that if cognizance is taken, the petitioners may file a fresh anticipatory bail application.

The prayer is allowed. The anticipatory bail application is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty that the petitioners, if so required after taking cognizance, may file fresh anticipatory bail application.
