3 21-09-2015 The instant writ application has been filed for quashing the first information report of Ranitalab P. S. Case No. 140 of 2012 dated 13.11.2012 registered under Sections 467, 468, 471, 420, 323, 504, 506, 120 B of the Indian Penal Code.
