ORAL ORDER

2 20-02-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 41(2)(h) and 42 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 and section 414 IPC.

From the orchard of the petitioner 48 logs of was recovered.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner purchased Khair wood from Ujjwal Kumar Singh for which he had taken adequate permit to transport. Statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named

petitioner be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 148 of 2014 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
