Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 11(d)(e) of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act,1960.

It is alleged that the petitioner being the driver of pick-up van was carrying five animals.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is simply a driver of public carrier when the animals were validly purchased and the animals in question were not stolen one. Statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named

petitioner be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Gopalganj in connection with Mirganj P.S. Case No. 332 of 2014 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
