The whole issue now boils down to the fact that the Board of Directors have to take a decision on the absorption of these petitioners who have alleged discrimination. Since in the decision of the Board taken in the year 2012, the matter was adjourned for the reasons indicated in the said resolution and almost three years have

passed now it is high time that finality on the status of these petitioners is achieved.

The writ application is disposed of with a direction upon the Managing Director to ensure that a Board meeting will convene well in time and a final decision is taken before 31st of December, 2015. A long adjournment or time frame has been granted to the Corporation in view of the stand of the counsel representing the Corporation that the Managing Director is also part-time Deputy Election Commissioner of the State of Bihar.
