learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are the family members who are apprehending their arrest in Complaint Case no.465c/13 for the offences under Sections 323, 498 (A), 379, 380, 504 of the I.P.C. and Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.
