16 22-07-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned AC to SC-24 as well as Sri Kumar Priya Ranjan, learned counsel for the Accountant General, Bihar.

The present petition has been filed with a prayer to initiate contempt proceeding against Opp.Parties on an allegation of wilful disobedience to an order dated 19.10.2011 passed in C.W.J.C.No.15917 of 2011.

In this case, number of show cause and supplementary show cause have been filed on behalf of Opp.Parties. In the last supplementary show cause filed on behalf of the State as well as the Accountant General, it has been indicated that final pension and gratuity has already been authorized. It was submitted that the

petitioner is already getting family pension.
