ORAL ORDER

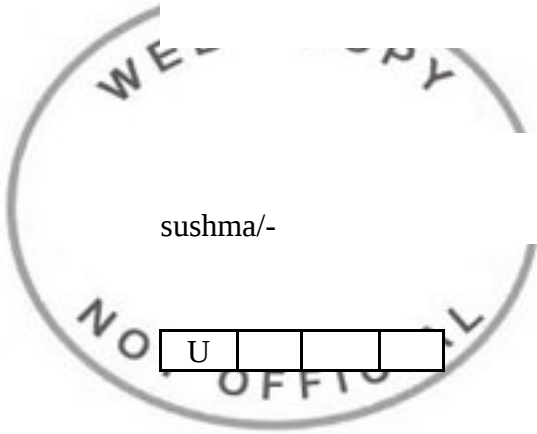
2 11-09-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
