The decision to recover Rs. 35,412/- in terms of Annexure-2, dated 18th September, 2014, is quashed with a direction upon respondent no. 4, the Additional District Magistrate-cum-District-Incharge-Officer, Mid Day Meal Programme, Nawada, that he will issue a show cause to the petitioner, consider the same and then pass a fresh order in accordance with law.

The petitioner is directed to cooperate in the matter and will not try to avoid either answering the show cause or receiving the show cause. He will present himself before the respondent no. 4 with a copy of this order, who shall in turn do the

needful. The petitioner must appear before respondent no. 4 within one week from today.

The writ application is allowed in terms of the above directions.
